FMs believe that over the next 12 months they will be most impacted by:

- 1. Managing and implementing new technologies (27%)
- Meeting increased sustainability demands (24%)
- 3. Increases to material costs (22%)
- More to do within job spec but the same amount of time to do it in (20%)
- 5. Impacts of new legislation e.g. The Building Safety Bill (19%)

TIPS FROM THE EXPERTS

- Introduce a maintenance rota to help stay on top of repair jobs and prevent damage from worsening
- Review business processes and identify opportunities to implement sustainable solutions
- Schedule regular team checkins to identify, discuss and support personal development opportunities
